Sabah teacher wins Macmillan scholarship

KUALA LUMPUR: Passionate about teaching and focused on providing his students with an enriching English language experience, Mohd Sirhajwan Idek from Sabah made his school proud by being the only Malaysian to win the Macmillan English scholarship.

The 29-year-old teacher at Keningau Vocational College was listed as one of the five winners of the Macmillan Education Teachers at the Heart scholarship, which entitles him to a two-week training course at the Nile Institute in the United Kingdom.

The four other winners were Walid Chaafi from Emtez Preparatory School in Tunisia, Cares Diaz Farré of Escola Ramon Llull in Spain, Ksemia Immel of British Club Language School in Russia and Anastaisa Reva of State School "Spring Voices" in Russia.

PETALING JAYA: Malaysia's award-winning teacher has done the country proud again.

Mohd Sirhajwan Idek, an English teacher from Keningau Vocational College, has fended off eight other finalists' bid to win the International Innovation and Entrepreneurship Excellence in Teaching Award 2017.

The competition, which ended on Friday at the Novancia Business School in Paris, was part of this year's European Conference of Innovation and Entrepreneurship (ECIE).

The 29-year-old, who presented case studies alongside fellow finalists from the United States, Britain, Russia, Germany, Canada, Denmark and Colombia, was the only Asian and the only teacher in the group. Others were lecturers.

A MULTIPLE international award-winning English teacher from Keningau, Sabah, won accolades for his teaching project, "Wonder Zone", at the International Association of Teachers of English as a Foreign Language Conference held in Brighton recently.

Explaining his winning project, Sirhajwan said, "We initially selected a particular primary school and our students, in pairs, chose a specific issue such as health, hygiene, literacy and sports.

"They developed their own projects and eventually carried them out on the pupils from four schools. It was a month-long continuous project.

Kuala Lumpur: Seorang guru Kolej Vokasional-Keningau, Sabah Mohd Sirhajwan Idek melakar sejarah apabila terpilih sebagai finalis Hadiah Guru Global yang akan berlangsung di Dubai Mac 2017.

Menurut laman web www.globalteacherprize.org, Mohd Sirhajwan; 29, disenarai pendek daripada 20,000 pencalonan guru dari 179 negara menyertai pertandingan antarabangsa menawarkan hadiah RM4.42 juta (AS\$1 juta). Menerusi laman web itu,

Mohd Sirhajwan memberitahu mengajar adalah sangat mencabar di luar bandar Malaysia kerana pelajar-pelajarnya datang dari keluarga berstatus sosioekonomi rendah yang mempunyai pendedahan sedikit kepada dunia luar.

Katanya, ini turut bermakna penguasaan bahasa Inggeris dalam kalangan pelajar luar bandar lebih rendah.

KVC wins big in Seoul

WINNING four gold medals and four special awards at the World Invention Innovation Contest (WIC) in Seoul was the best ever achievement by a group of teachers and students from Keningau Vocational College (KVC) recently.

The gold medalist recipients were teachers Mohd Sirhajwan Idek for his Think Tales innovation and Sauman Maliki (Pastry Dough). Two other gold medals came from a collaboration between teachers Michael Dungli and Sadzul Hamzasin, and students Terrence Fong and Mohd Azley Jaldy for their entries - Mini Fogging and Easy Tiles Installer, respectively.

Sirhajwan, who is also the head of the Malaysian delegation, said winning the world-class awards was a great achievement.

"It felt awesome and what made it more special was that I won a gold medal with my colleagues and students. When we were in Seoul, there were six of us and we had four entries in the competition.

"All four innovations were awarded with gold medals and I felt so happy for my colleagues and students as they deserved the recognition for their dedication and creativity.

"Malaysia also beat more advanced countries like the United States. We have done our best for the country. This victory is our gift to Malaysians, especially our parents, the people of KVC and Sabah," he said.

WIC is a globally recognised annual innovation competition held in Seoul. It provides opportunities for students, inventors, innovators and research scientists to express their creativity through their inventions.

The two-day WIC championship at Chungmu Art Centre in South Korea was organised by the Korean Invention News, with the participation of 10 countries.

Sirhajwan said it had been a common practice among teachers to help and support each other in developing their innovations and participate in the competition, especially in Sabah.

He said their participation in the competition had inspired other teachers and students to unleash their creativity and pursue their dreams.

"There are now more teachers and students in our college that are determined to develop their ideas and seize every available opportunity to display and demonstrate their capabilities and talent.

"In fact, there are also teachers from other schools who would like to collaborate with us."

Sirhajwan's winning idea, Think Tales, is a collection of ESL materials, including short stories and poems on the indigenous cultures of



in English, Sirhajwan said he was able to get them to talk about their cultures, hometown, childhood and families in English as a post-reading activity.

"They have been very engaged in sharing their stories, in which their stories ranged from mythological creatures to traditional games, and their dream jobs to their families. The stories were also about the lessons they learned from their past experiences or the native languages of their ethnicity.

"They are motivated to do research on myths and legends from their hometowns. Think Tales also serves as a great reading activity in train-
